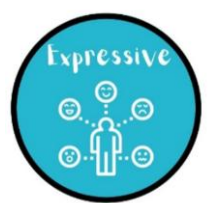

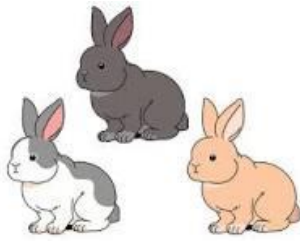


It's nearly World Book Day!
