On Monday 19th May 5 Seacole visited Ford Green Hall in Stoke-on Trent, which was built in 1624. It is an award-winning museum which enabled the children to experience the life of the 17th century. They were able to see many examples of textiles, ceramics and furniture that people in the Tudor and Stuart periods would have used. The children demonstrated their knowledge by answering and asking many questions. They were real historians for the day, handling objects and determining their use, listening to phrases that we still use today and how they originated (*“sleep tight, don't let the bed bugs bite”*) and dressing in clothes of the period. They had an amazing day and were true ambassadors for our school.

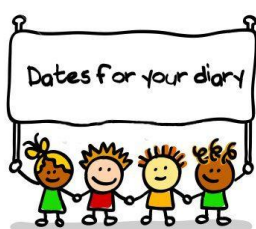
The children in Reception Elizabeth had a great time being Scientists as they made 'human bubbles!' and made the biggest bubbles they could before they burst!
