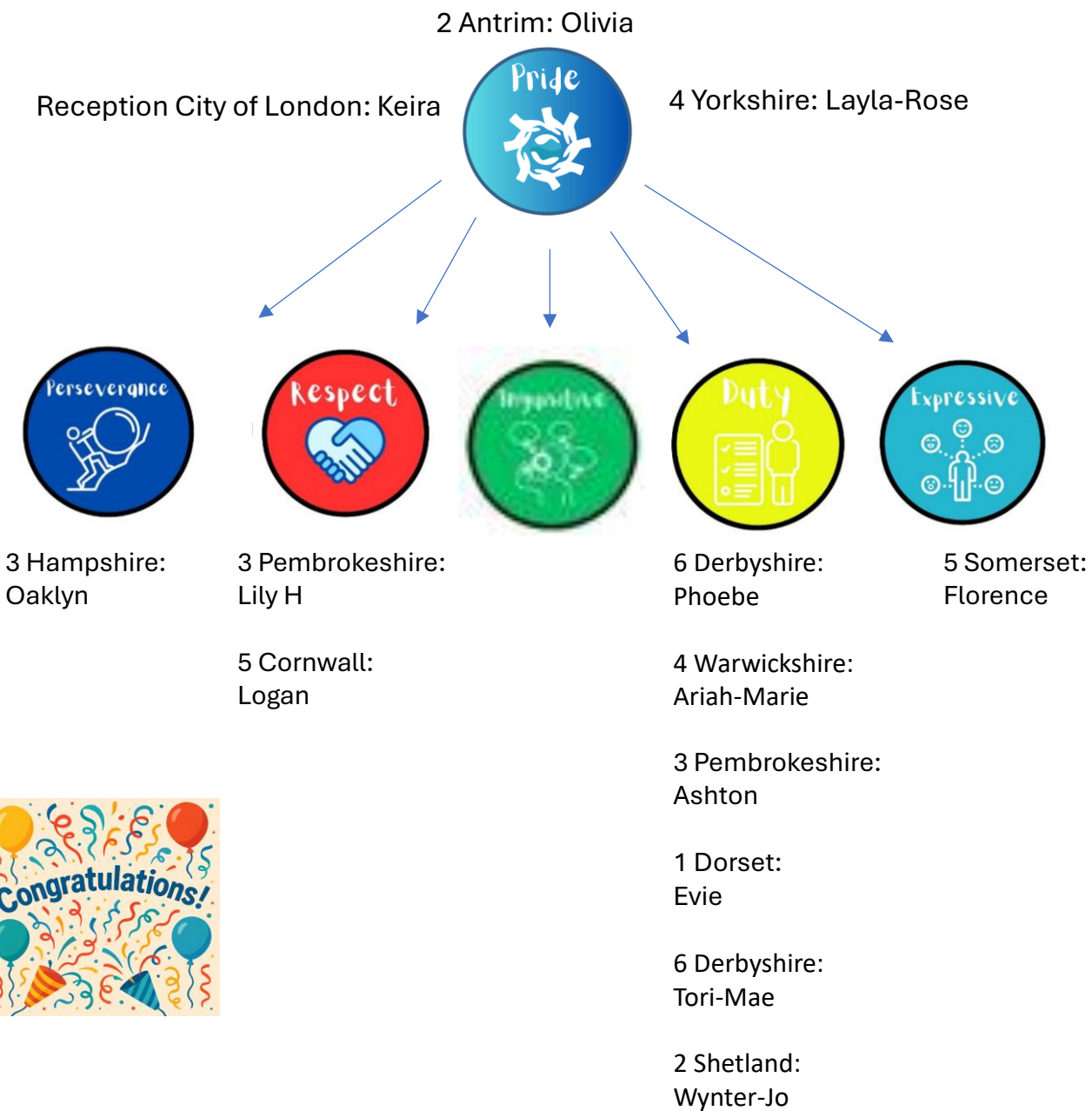

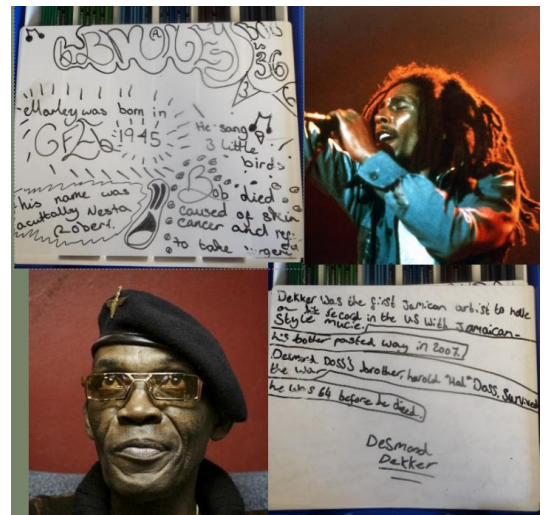
Year 4 have demonstrated their knowledge of Steel Pans as they now use two beaters.
