

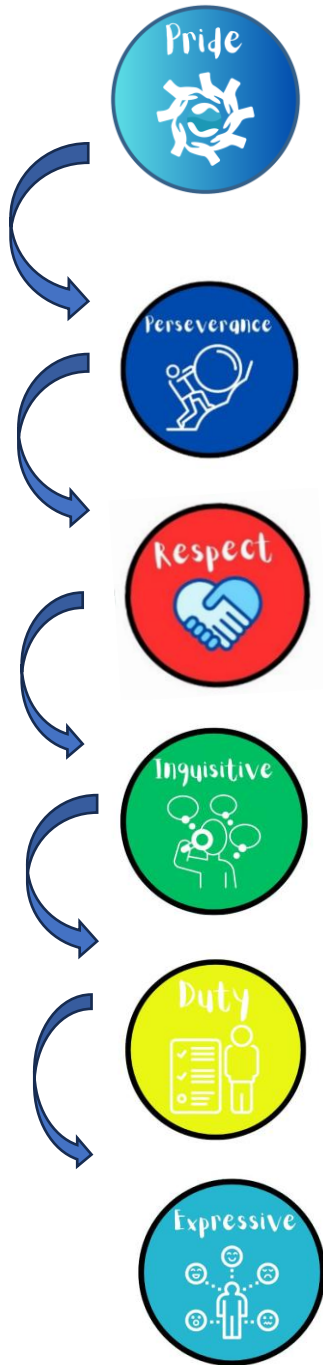

Congratulations to four children in **1 Dorset** who reached the end of their reading journey this week and visited Mrs McKay for their book rewards!

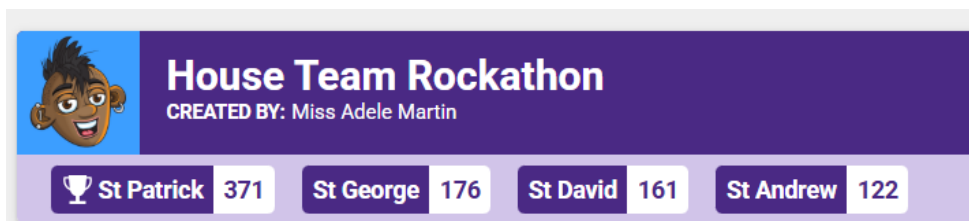
