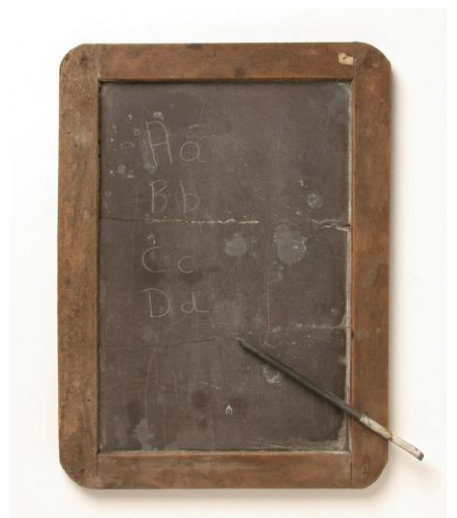

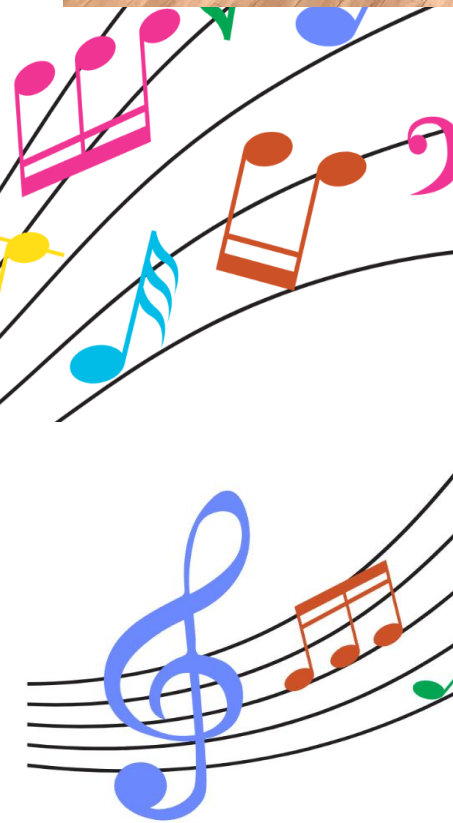
1 Dorset – Enjoying the sunshine!
