

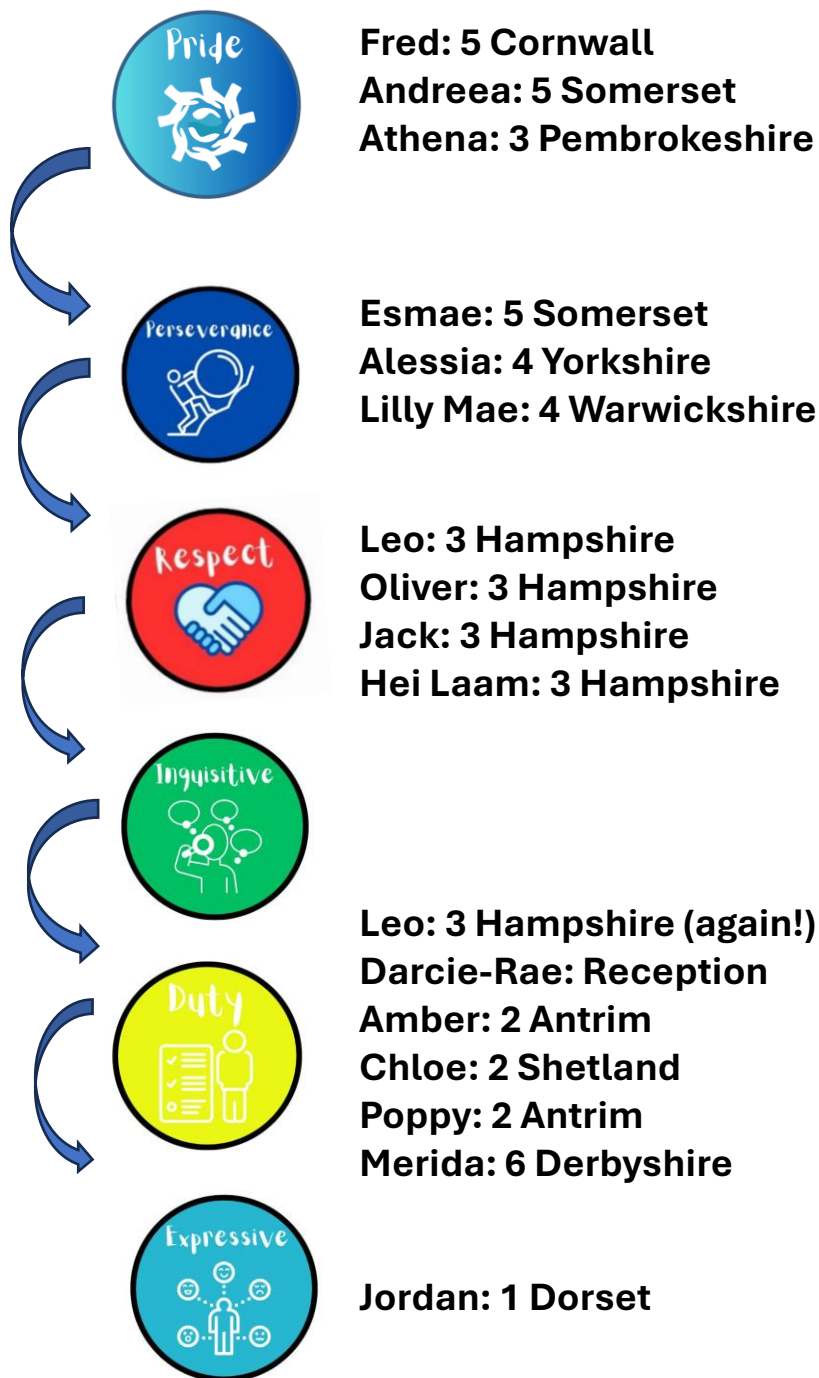

Fred (5 Cornwall) visited every cloakroom in school with Mrs McKay and after some harsh judging he chose...

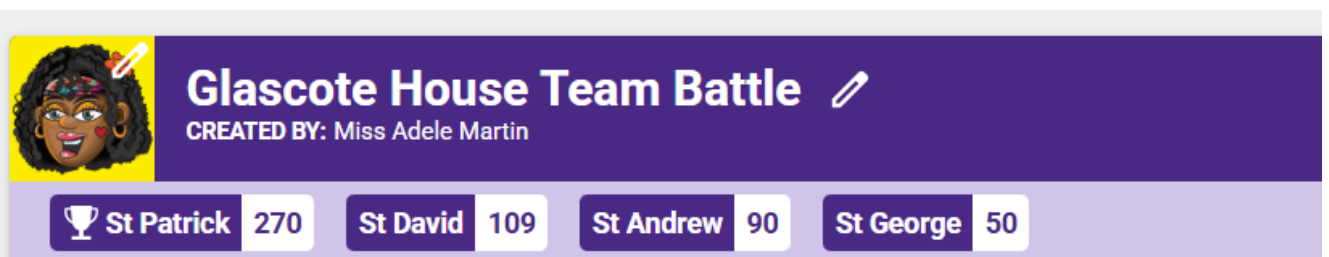
